Christmas Eve Service – Wednesday, Dec 24th at 5 pm with Pr Erin preaching





PRAYER OF THE DAY


The Lord be with you.

- B: We light again the candles of hope and peace and joy, because in Jesus, heaven came to earth.


Light the first, second, and third candles.


WALK-ON CHRISTMAS PAGEANT 2025


